PSO01: English Literature Proficiency: Graduates will be well-versed in the various literary genres, historical periods, and important English literary works. They would possess the ability to assess and comprehend literary works critically.

PSO08: Cultural Sensitivity: Tolerance for differing opinions and cultural sensitivity are encouraged in this course. Graduates should be able to engage with literature from a variety of cultures, places, and identities in order to support an inclusive approach to literary studies.
